


June 2025: EMS Insights on Drowning-Related Responses

Background


Drowning is responsible for approximately 4,000 fatalities and 8,000 non-fatal injuries each year in the U.S.¹ Drowning is the leading cause of death in U.S. children between 1 and 4 years old.¹
